
I am requesting funding for the Threat Assessment Center Radio Infrastructure and Intelligence Project in Fiscal Year 2027. The entity to receive funding for this project is the County of Stanislaus, located at 1010 10th Street, Suite 6800 Modesto, CA 95354.

The funding would be for the development of the Stanislaus County Sheriff's Threat Assessment Center (STAC) into a fully operational Real-Time Crime Center by upgrading radio infrastructure, improving signal reliability, and implementing DOJ-required encrypted communication. This project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds as it will eliminate internal communication failures, strengthen officer safety, and enable real-time coordination with local and federal partners.

This project has a federal nexus because it is for the purposes authorized by section 1701(b)(9) of the Omnibus Crime Control and Safe Streets Act of 1968 (34 U.S.C. § 10381(b)(9)).
